<b>DEFINITION</b>	A permanent, usually freestanding, off-premises sign affixed to the ground or to a building, owned by a person, corporation or other entity that engages in the business of selling or leasing the advertising space on the sign and which advertises an establishment, service, commodity, goods or entertainment sold or offered on premises other than that on which such sign is located. Such signs commonly referred to as “outdoor advertising signs” are generally designed so that the copy or posters on the sign can be changed frequently.

<b>PERMITTED HEIGHT (feet)</b>															25	30
<b>COPY AREA COMPLIANCE</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The permitted copy area for Billboard Signs will be measured by the total square feet of the sign itself which will need to comply with the max square feet of the underlying zoning district.</li> </ul>															
<b>LOCATION RESTRICTIONS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>No billboard shall be located within 2,000 feet of any other billboard.</li> <li>No billboard shall be located within 500 feet of any residential zoning district or residential structure.</li> </ul>															
<b>NUMBER OF SIGN FACES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Billboards may display a single face or a double sign face where the two faces of the sign are situated back-to-back and parallel to each other.</li> </ul>															
<b>LANDSCAPING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The area below the sign within a radius of 15 feet of the support structure shall be landscaped and maintained with a vegetative <a href="#">ground cover</a> and <a href="#">shrubs</a> in compliance with Section <a href="#">30-5.B.1</a>, Landscaping Standards, with shrubs planted at a rate of one per five square feet.</li> </ul>
