



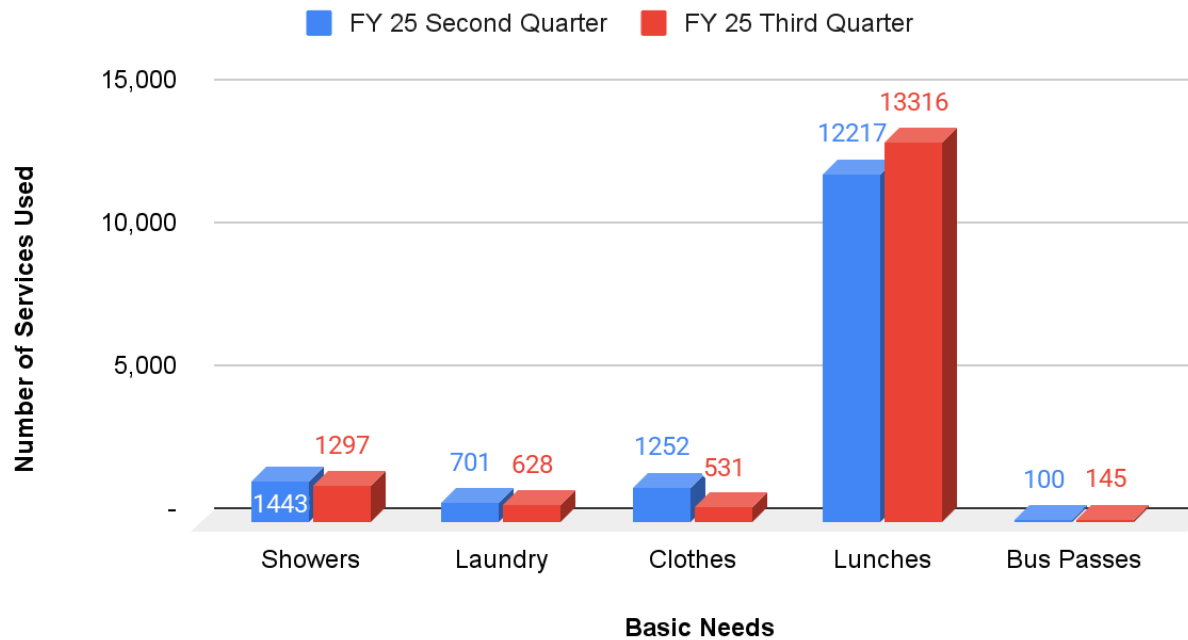

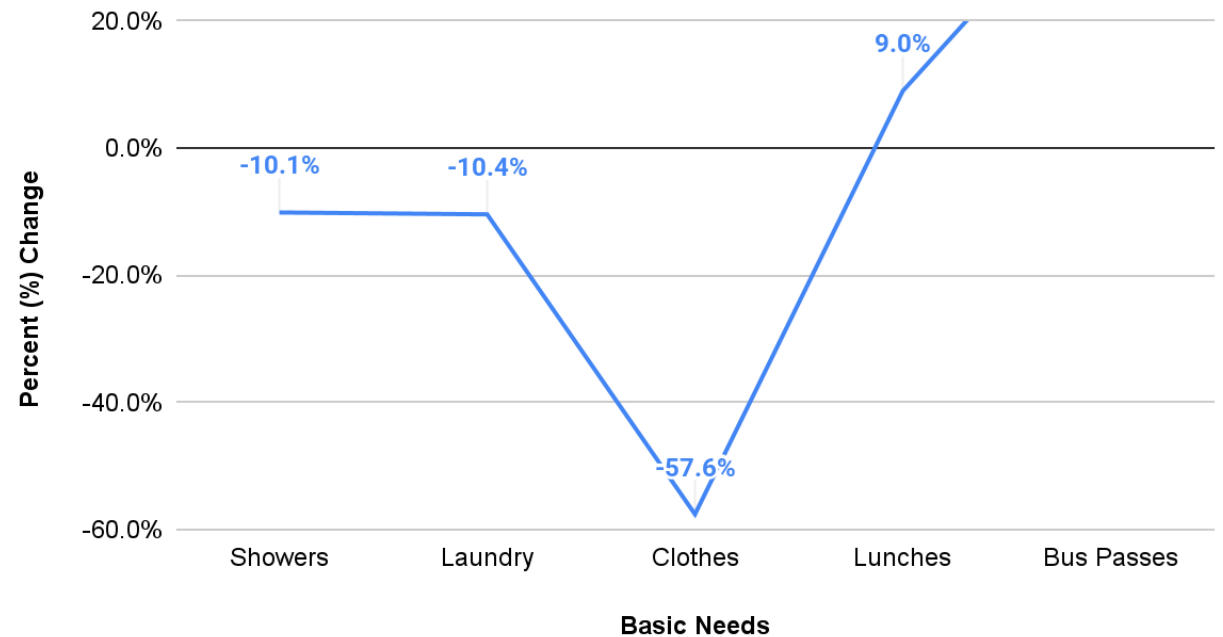

Comparison of Basic Needs Usage: Q2 25/26 vs. Q3 25/26



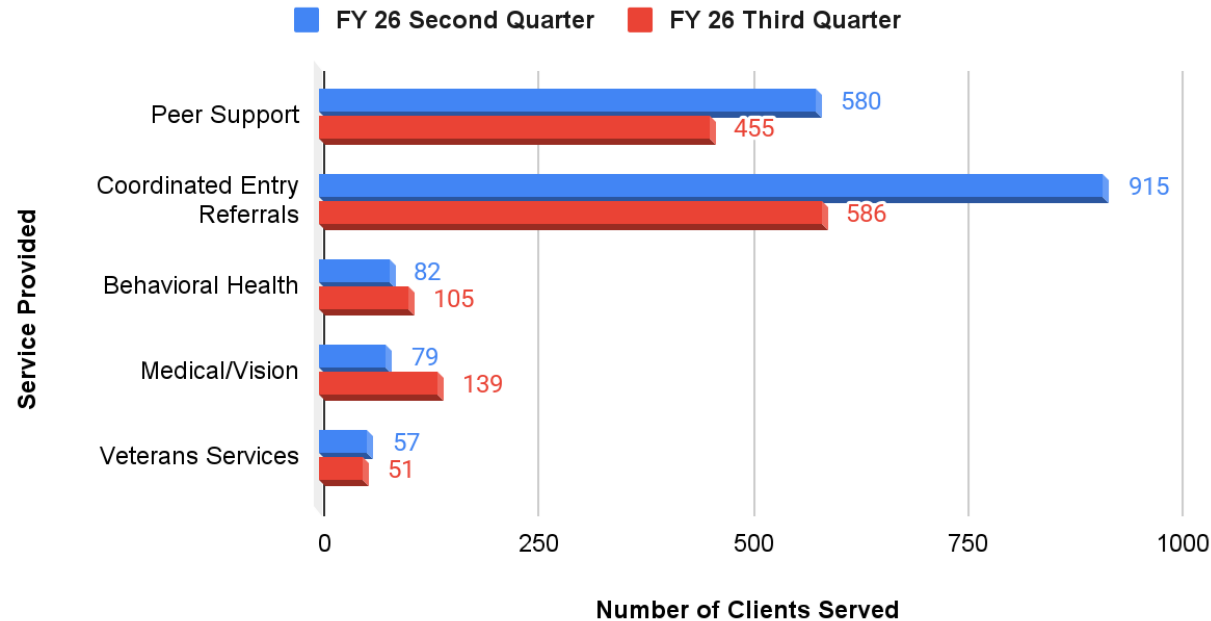
Growth & Decline in Services between Q2 and Q3 25/26



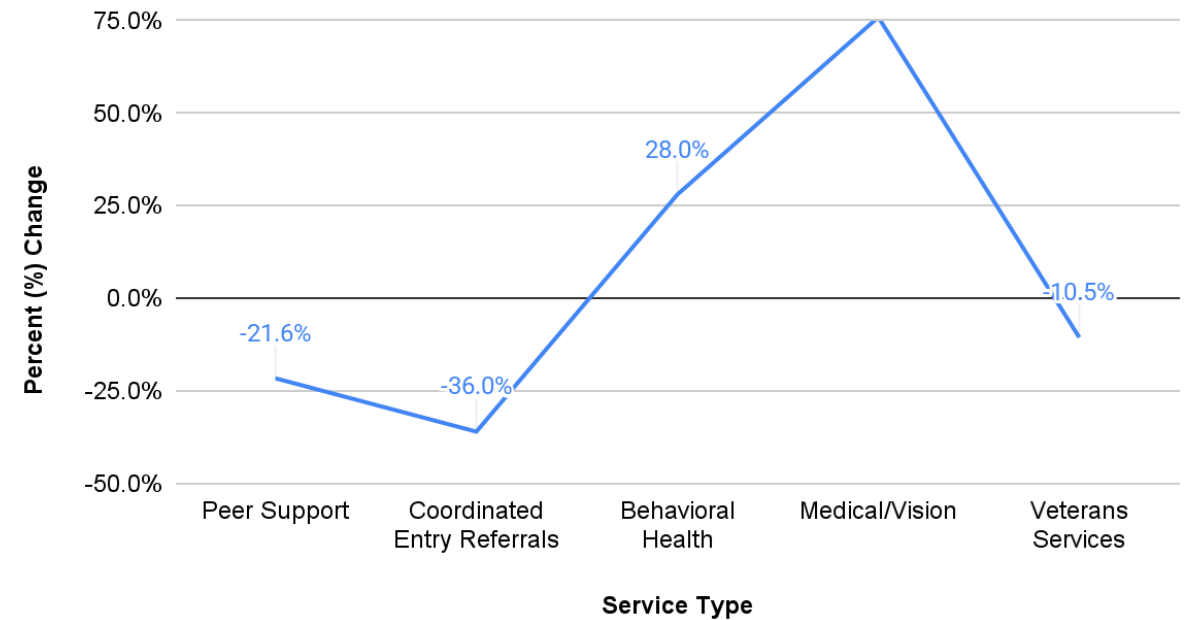
Considerations:

- White Flag Nights

- Winter weather patterns decrease overall service usage
- Transition to Emergency/Basic needs clothing only

Growth & Decline in Services between Q2 and Q3 25/26



Considerations:

- Veteran services decrease reflects one veteran successfully housed
- Coordinated Entry (CE) increased numbers in Q2 due to HOPE program
- Limited CE staffing (often one employee on site)
- Peer support decrease due to a Provider's decreased funding and loss of staff
