Dear Mr. Healy:

It was a pleasure to meet with you and David Winslow last week to discuss the North Carolina Civil War and Reconstruction History Center project. As I mentioned, the taxable value of the land transferred by the City for this project totals almost \$870,000. As evidenced by past monetary grants of \$100,000 and the unanimous pledge by City Council to provide up to \$7.5M towards this project, contingent upon receiving matching Cumberland County support and State funding, the City supports this project. In discussions with the City Council, we desire to have the \$870,000 land value credited to the City's \$7.5M pledge. Therefore, the remaining pledge for the City of Fayetteville is approximately \$6.6 M.

If needed or requested by your Board, the City Council can clarify their desire through a new resolution of support for this project.
