What do you envision accomplishing with this agenda item request?

Purpose: Rezone Brunswick/Yadkin to Brunswick and Halifax a No-Parking Zone with towing enforcement.

The Cottonade Community has an entrance at the intersection of Yadkin Road and Brunswick Road, about 500 yds from an entrance to Ft. Liberty. For years, this entrance has been a de facto "Park & Ride" lot for folks who either don't have or have lost permission to drive on Base.
