Dear Mr. Pedigo:

This letter is in response to your request for a speed hump on Faison Avenue. This is a Non – Compliant Installation and the City of Fayetteville is providing the petition packet for you to gather the required signatures for the speed humps installation.

The City's Residential Traffic Management Program (RTMP) requires community support by execution of the petition. The RTMP requires agreement from 70% of the affected households and 100% agreement from the adjacent property owners.

The community should be aware the installation of speed humps would have negative impacts on emergency response times. Upon review of the RTMP, please sign and have the community to provide response (yes or no) to show agreement with the proposed improvements. Only one signature per address will be counted. Once the petition is executed, please submit to the Traffic Services Division for final review. By copy of this letter, we are providing our study results to the Fayetteville Police Department for any assistance they can provide with enforcement of this area.

Mr. Pedigo, we have enclosed a copy of the City's RTMP, a map of the affected area and petition. Also the petition can be filled on the city's website, https://www.fayettevillenc.gov/city-services/public-services/traffic-services.
