A RESOLUTION OF INTENT - THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE IN SUPPORT OF THE CAPE FEAR REGIONAL THEATRE FUNDING REQUEST

- **WHEREAS,** Cape Fear Regional Theatre (CFRT) is looking to expand and add height to support the theatre's rapid growth, and the proposed expansion is estimated to be \$20 million; and
- **WHEREAS,** CFRT has already received \$5 million from the State of North Carolina, \$5 million from individual donors and foundations for a total of \$10 million; and
- **WHEREAS,** CFRT is asking the City to support this expansion with a one-time \$2.5 million investment payable over five years; and
- **WHEREAS**, the City's commitment will ensure CFRT can begin construction of the expansion on schedule in the summer of 2024; and
- **WHEREAS,** the funding from the City is restricted to capital needs only, and failure to begin expansion, may result in CFRT refunding the City; and
- **WHEREAS** the City's commitment to pay \$500,000 each year for five years is subject to the annual appropriations; and
- **WHEREAS,** budget discussions by the Fayetteville City Council begin in earnest after January 1, of every fiscal year; and
- **WHEREAS,** the City can realize all the benefits of the expanded Cape Fear Regional Theatre without being responsible for any annual operating expenses; and
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** on behalf of the people of Fayetteville, this Council does hereby resolve that the City of Fayetteville, North Carolina, has agreed to endorse the Cape Fear Regional Theatre in Fayetteville, North Carolina, and the City will commit to an investment of 2.5 million dollars towards the expansion project;
- **PASSED AND APPROVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE, NORTH CAROLINA,** on this, the 26th day of June 2023; such meeting was held in compliance with the Open Meetings Act, at which meeting a quorum was present and voting.
