Program Title: Fayetteville Fire Department Summer Teen CERT & Fire Academy



Program Goals: Develop and implement programs aimed at engaging youth in general life skills, public safety education, and emergency response training, while fostering their interest in firefighting or other public safety careers to help recruit the next generation of first responders.

Program Duration: (1 Week) June 10th – June 14th. 9 am – 4 pm Monday –Thurs, Friday 9am-5pm



Curriculum overview: The curriculum of the camp includes but is not limited to Cert Basic Training Certification, Stop the Bleed, Hands-only CPR, teen depression & bullying, distracted teen driving, human trafficking, drugs & gangs, firearm safety, interacting with law enforcement, fire extinguisher training, financial awareness, and budgeting. The students participate in a fire department day where they are exposed to all the different pathways within the fire department. During the program, the students will also be exposed to multiple public safety career pathways.



Participant eligibility: Rising 9th – 12th graders, residing in Cumberland County (special exceptions can be made on a case-by-case basis).

Recruitment and Selection Process: Recruitment is focused on inner-city teens by reaching out through program partners. Additional recruitment is also forwarded to the local high schools and home school networks. Class size is limited to the first 25 that return completed applications. A waitlist is generally added in the event a student cannot make the class. *There is no participation fee for the students attending the camp.*



Partnerships: Partnerships include Cape Fear CERT, City of Fayetteville Fire Department, Cumberland County Sheriff's Office, Fayetteville Police Department, NC Highway Patrol, Cape Fear Valley Hospital System Trauma Program, LifeFlight AirCare, Marius Maximus Foundation for Mental Health, Stoney Point Fire Department.



Previous Program Outcomes: Since the program's inception we have had reports of students volunteering at their local county volunteer fire departments and other non-profits. In addition, we have had two teens receive the President's Volunteer Service Award Gold with four teens receiving the Bronze Award. Teens have also been recognized for their achievements in the community by the Mayor of Hope Mills and Cumberland County Commissioners. A former member of Cape Fear CERT was interested in joining the Fayetteville Fire Department and since then has successfully gained employment and is currently serving as part of our fire investigation team.
