

Proposed Overlay Area






Aerial Notification Map Case #: P23-18











Zoning Map






Land Use Map






Subject Property

Analysis

- Airport Entrance Corridor Overlay will be an amendment to the existing Airport Overlay District. This is a project done in conjunction with Cumberland County Planning as the area around Fayetteville Regional Airport is regulated by the City of Fayetteville and Cumberland County.
- Manufactured/mobile homes will not be permitted on properties within the AECO. Existing manufactured/mobile homes can remain.
- Of the 23 parcels located within the AECO, only 5 are within the City of Fayetteville's jurisdiction.
- The parcels within the City of Fayetteville's jurisdiction are currently zoned Light and Heavy Industrial. Manufactured/mobile homes are not permitted in these districts.



Recommendation

The Zoning Commission and Professional Planning Staff recommend that City Council APPROVE the map amendment for the AECO based on the following:

- The proposed zoning map amendment implements the policies adopted in the Future Land Use Plan (FLUP), and those policies found in the Unified Development Ordinance (UDO). The Future Land Use Plan calls for the subject property to be developed as Low Density Residential.
- The uses permitted by the proposed change in zoning district classification and the standards that apply to such uses would not be appropriate in the immediate area; and
- There are no other factors that will substantially affect public health, safety, morals, or general welfare.



Options

- 1. City Council approves of the map amendment/rezoning as presented based on the evidence submitted and finds that the map amendment/rezoning is consistent with the Future Land Use Plan as demonstrated by the attached consistency and reasonableness statement (Recommended)
- 2. City Council approves of the map amendment/rezoning to a more restrictive zoning district based on the evidence submitted and finds that the map amendment/rezoning would be consistent with the Future Land Use Plan and an amended consistency and reasonableness statement.
- City Council denies the map amendment/rezoning based on the evidence submitted and finds that the map amendment/rezoning is inconsistent with the Future Land Use Plan.





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
