Mayor Colvin called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Mayor Colvin asked the Council to review the regular agenda for the October 27, 2025, meeting.

Council Member Haire recommended leaving Item 7.0A5 - Approve Ordinances for Uninhabitable Structures: Demolition Recommendations 1912 Murchison Road District 4 and 2005 Murchison Road District 4 on the demolition list. Council Member Greene asked when the City demolishes a location like a cleaner or body shop that may have hazardous materials in the ground does the City have a liability. Dr. Gerald Newton, Development Services Director, stated staff completes all the environmental requirements before demolition.

Ms. Kelly Strickland, Assistant City Manager, stated the applicant of one of the Public Hearings requested the hearings be moved before Staff Reports. Ms. Strickland stated residents opposed to Item 9.01 - P25-30: A request to rezone 2211 Rosehill Road (0438470005000), consisting of 21.27 acres and owned by Cross Creek Refuse LLC, from Single Family Residential 6 (SF-6) to Mixed Residential 5 (MR-5). (Tabled from August 25) emailed requesting it be tabled for a full year. The applicant has requested it be tabled until the next regular meeting. Council Member Davis stated he will make a motion to move Item 9.01 to January. Ms. Lachelle Pulliam, City Attorney, stated at the approval of the agenda the movement of the items can be completed in the same motion. Discussion ensued.

Mayor Pro Tem Jensen requested information on the Junior Mayor. Mr. Brook Redding, Senior Assistant to the City Manager, stated the chair of the Fayetteville-Cumberland Youth Council (FCYC) is a two-year term and the Junior Mayor was created in the middle of the term. The incumbent will serve another year as the Junior Mayor and then it will come to City Council moving forward.
