

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING FAYETTEVILLE AREA SYSTEM OF TRANSIT TO ESTABLISH AND SUBMIT THE 2019-2021 DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS ENTERPRISE PROGRAM AND GOAL TO THE FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION

WHEREAS, as an eligible recipient of federal-aid funding, the City of Fayetteville is required to comply with Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 26, which states that grantees must establish and implement a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) program and annually set DBE participation targets; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) process requires grantees to provide information annually that includes the following:

- 1) The grantee's three year goal; and
- 2) The methodology for establishing the goal; and
- 3) Identification of the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Liaison Officer (DBELO); and
- 4) Prompt payment provisions to be used in contracts; and
- 5) Semi-annual reporting of the Uniform Report of DBE Awards or Commitments and Payments; and

WHEREAS, the City is required to update the DBE program on file with the FTA each time the program is amended; and

WHEREAS, the City has established an overall goal for DBE participation that will include race conscience and race neutral components; and

WHEREAS, the City must calculate race conscious DBE goals and incorporate new race conscious contract specifications into all federal-aid consultant, construction, and Transit operating, vehicle and service contracts; and

WHEREAS, the City authorizes Fayetteville Area System of Transit to take all necessary steps to comply with Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 26.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by City Council of the City of Fayetteville City that the Fayetteville Area System of Transit be authorized to take all necessary steps to establish and submit the 2018-2020 Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Goal and to sign DBE Implementation agreements and any related amendments with the Federal Transit Administration.
