- A formal change to a HUD-approved Annual Action Plan that is significant enough to require public notice, citizen participation, and City Council approval.
- Substantial Amendments are needed in this case due to:
 - Shifting funding between activities,
 - Adding a new activity, and
 - Accepting newly awarded funds from HUD.



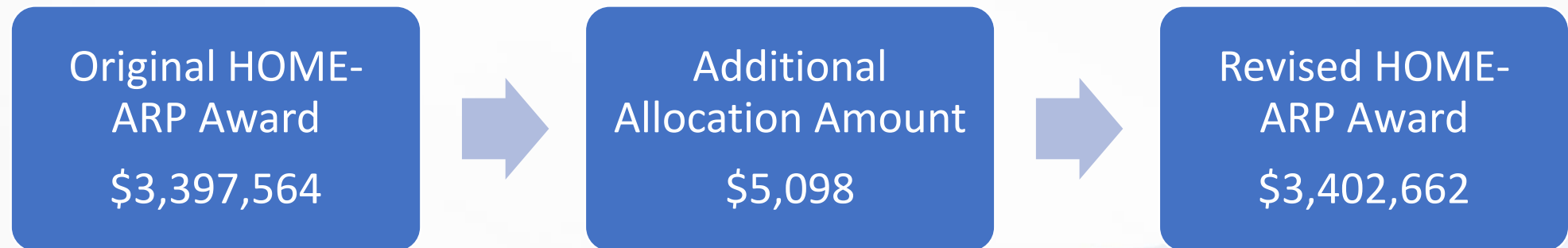
- **2021-2022 Annual Action Plan**

- Adopted by Council May 14, 2021
- HOME-ARP allocation of \$3,397,564

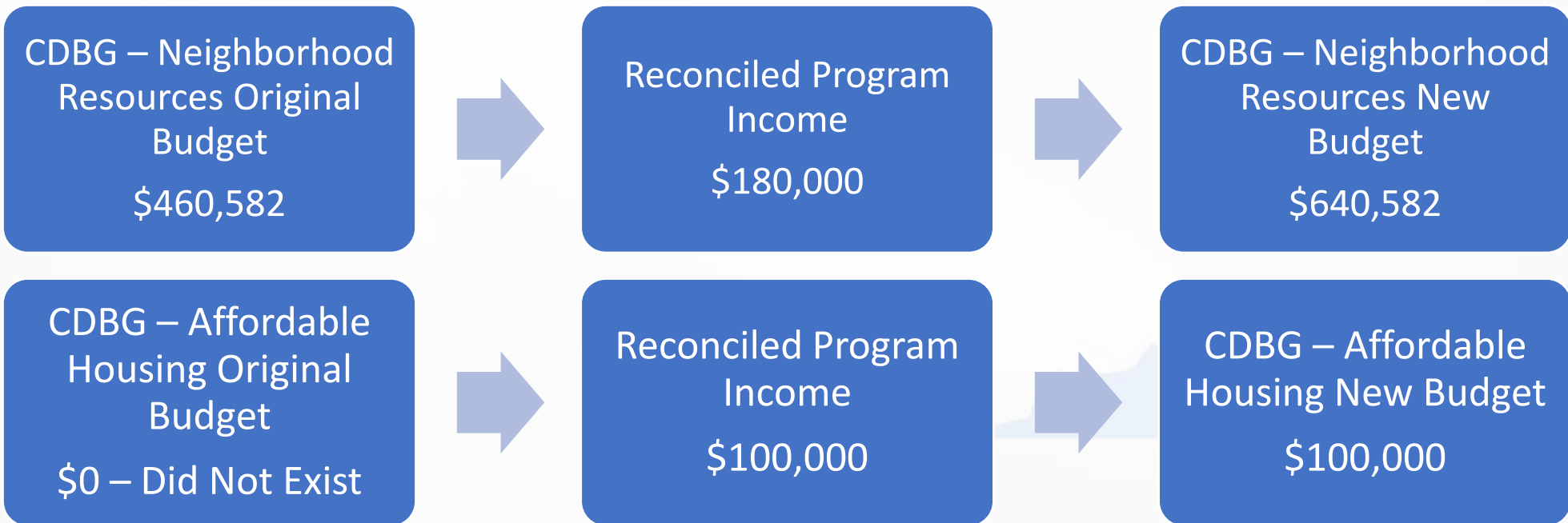
- **2025-2026 Annual Action Plan**

- Adopted by Council April 28, 2025
- Allocated \$460,582 to CDBG – Neighborhood Resources
- No CDBG – Affordable Housing activity at time of adoption

- Revised award notice received on April 30, 2025.
- Instructed to amend Annual Action Plan in accordance with City's citizen participation plan.
- Public notice and comment period: September 4 – October 5, 2025



- Program income was reconciled from previous funding cycles.
- Shifting funding between activities and adding a new activity.
- Public notice and comment period: September 4 – October 5, 2025
