Describe the services performed in your community:

Fayetteville Fire Department is a municipal fire department that employs an all-hazards response model. The department responds to all types of calls for service to include fire suppression, emergency medical services at the EMT level (no transport), technical rescues, and hazardous materials releases. The department also provides community risk reduction services to include public education, smoke detector and carbon monoxide alarm installs, child safety seat inspections, code enforcement, and fire investigations.

Fayetteville Fire Department primarily provides service within the municipal boundaries of the City of Fayetteville but responds into surrounding jurisdictions using mutual and automatic aid agreements with Cumberland County, Ft Liberty Fire & Emergency Services, and Hoke County.

Specific to industrial firefighting equipment, the department has the following:

- Daspit tool with Ranger nozzle and ground/mobile mount
- Ambassador Trailer w/Hydro-Foam nozzle capable of flowing 4,000+ gallons per minute
- Flatbed trailer with 10 totes (265 gallons each) of Thunderstorm AR-AFFF foam (2,650 gal total)

All equipment was purchased by Motiva LLC in 2012 and given to Fayetteville Fire Department to provide the necessary firefighting capabilities for the installation of tank 704 at the Fayetteville complex.
