

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE, NORTH CAROLINA, SUPPORTING PARKING PROHIBITIONS ON BROADFOOT AVENUE (SR1414) IN THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE

WHEREAS, North Carolina General Statutes § 160A-301 states “a city may by ordinance regulate, restrict, and prohibit the parking of vehicles on the public streets, alleys, and bridges within the city”; and

WHEREAS, the Fayetteville City Council has determined that parking outside of the designated parking spaces along Broadfoot Avenue (SR1414) from Morganton Road (SR1404) to Raeford Road (SR1414) / Arsenal Avenue is a traffic safety hazard; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fayetteville has a long-standing cooperative relationship with the North Carolina Department of Transportation.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED on behalf of the people of Fayetteville, by the City Council of the City of Fayetteville, that the North Carolina Department of Transportation is hereby encouraged to post signage or any other devices denoting that vehicular parking shall be prohibited outside of the designated parking spaces along Broadfoot Avenue (SR1414) from Morganton Road (SR1404) to Raeford Road (SR1414) / Arsenal Avenue, to be effective thirty (30) days after the execution of North Carolina Department of Transportation Encroachment Permit E062-026-25-00996.
