








## Total SS Alerts City Wide: 569

Total SS Alerts by District




Percentage of SS Alerts by District




## Total # Shots (audible) Detected City Wide: 1920

Total # Shot Detections By District





Percentage of Shot Counts Detected by District






## Comparison of SS Alerts with no 911 call to Alerts in conjunction with 911 Calls




### Gun Recovery (15) and Arrests (22)





## Alert Hot Spots



**Purpose:** To provide awareness of Shot Spotter Alert “Hot Spots” indicating where a preponderance of alert events have occurred within each district coverage zone.





## Top Locations by Alert Count



### Top 10 Blocks - Incidents per block









## Top Locations by Rounds Count

### Top 10 Blocks Rounds per block






## Period of Occurrences
