Fayetteville City Council Work Session

Subject: Funding request for delegation visit from Saint Avold, France, Sept. 25 – Oct. 1, 2023

Amount requested: \$12,500

Details:

- 1. September 27, 2023, will mark the 30th Anniversary of Fayetteville's official adoption of Saint Avold as its International Sister City
- 2. An official delegation from Saint Avold has not visited Fayetteville in approximately 10 years.
- 3. The sitting Mayor of Saint Avold has never visited Fayetteville, nor has any Mayor.
- 4. The Fayetteville-Saint Avold Friendship Alliance has been fundraising and has received a \$1000 donation for the purpose of supporting this weeklong visit, but additional support is needed.
- 5. Previous delegations from Fayetteville have been very generously hosted during visits to Saint Avold, to include coverage of all lodging and meals expenses.

Anticipated expenses:

- 1. Lodging: 4 rooms for 6 nights at The McPherson House Bed & Breakfast: \$5, 464.68
 - a. In discussion regarding receiving a discount from this rate
 - b. Includes room and breakfast each morning.
 - c. Location proximity to downtown make this an optimal option for lodging.
- 2. Meals: Lunch and Dinners for 4 days for 4 people
 - a. Arrival evening (Monday) reception hosted by the FSAFA Board
 - b. Cost of meals for Tuesday, Wednesday (including anniversary dinner) Thursday, Friday and Saturday
- 3. Visit to USS North Carolina/Wilmington: Tickets \$14 each/\$56 total.
- 4. 30th Anniversary Dinner: Wednesday, Sept. 27, 2023 at The Sky View on Hay.
 - a. Room rental: \$2,312 includes tables and chairs for 100 people. Includes set-up and take down.
 - b. Linens costs (tablecloths) \$22.88 per table (approximately 13 tables), approx. \$298
 - c. Catered meal paid for delegation guest: approximately \$50 per person, \$200 total.
- 5. Saint Avold Avenue sign unveiling reception Veterans Park reception.
 - a. Catered lunch reception Publix, southern buffet style, iced tea, lemonade, finger foods, fried chicken strips, paper products approximately \$750
- 6. Transportation to and from the Raleigh-Durham International Airport, Sept. 25 pick-up, Oct. 1 drop-off. Cost associated: ?
