The Public Arts Commission serves as a resident advisory board to the Mayor and City Council, focusing on the integration of art into the city's public spaces to enhance the community's aesthetics and economic vitality.

- **Enhance Quality of Life:** Create vibrant and culturally rich public spaces that foster community pride.
- **Drive Economic Growth:** Strengthen the local economy by supporting cultural tourism and increasing foot traffic to local businesses.
- **Bridge Art & Governance:** Serving as the liaison between the local government, The Arts Council, and the public.
