

SPECIAL REVENUE FUND PROJECT ORDINANCE CLOSEOUT
SRCLO 2025-2 (SRO 2021-19)

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Fayetteville, North Carolina, that pursuant to Section 13.2 of Chapter 159 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, the following special revenue fund project ordinance is hereby closed:

Section 1. The project closing authorized is to Special Revenue Fund Project Ordinance 2021-19, adopted June 28, 2021, to fund a forgivable loan to Woodford, LLC for the renovation of a building at 125 Drake Street, as funded under a Building Reuse Program grant from the NC Department of Commerce, Rural Economic Development Division.

Section 2. The project director is hereby directed to proceed with the necessary closing entries and collection of any and all grant and loan agreements outstanding.
