




CALL VOLUME



COMMUNITY RISK REDUCTION





- Fire safety game days have extended into summer "after school" programs with CRR
- Teamed up with Fayetteville State to teach CPR during swimming for "at risk" youth and senior citizens
- Teamed up with "Habitat for Humanity" to teach CPR to personnel and families
- Created fire safety education games and activities for youth fire setting interventions and the senior population
- Partnered with the Cumberland County library to provide intervention meeting rooms, books, and programs that we can distribute to families for positive alternatives.
