## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE, NORTH CAROLINA, DECLARING 0.03 ACRES ON WRIGHT STREET SURPLUS PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING THE UPSET BID PROCESS AND SALE OF PROPERTY

**WHEREAS**, the City of Fayetteville owns a 0.03 acre parcel located on Wright Street described as Lot 2, Block B of the Wilmington Road NDP Sec. 1 Project NCA-10 as recorded in Plat Book 42, Page 9 of the Cumberland County Registry; and

**WHEREAS,** North Carolina General Statutes §160A-269 permits the City to sell property by upset bid, after receipt of an offer for the property; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has received an offer to purchase the property described above, in the amount of \$280.00, submitted by Ms. Willie Mae Spell; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Willie Mae Spell has paid the required five percent (5%) deposit on her offer;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** on behalf of the City Council of the City of Fayetteville, North Carolina that:

- 1. The City Council authorizes the sale of the property described above through the upset bid procedure pursuant to North Carolina General Statutes §160A-269.
- 2. A notice of the proposed sale will be published describing the property, amount of the offer, and state the terms under which the offer may be upset.
- 3. Persons wishing to upset the offer that has been received shall submit a sealed bid form and deposit within 10 days as described in the notice.
- 4. The City reserves the right to withdraw the property from sale at any time and has the right to reject any bids received.
- 5. If no qualifying upset bid is received after the initial public notice, the offer set forth above is hereby accepted and the City Council authorizes the City Manager to execute all necessary documents to move forward with the execution of the above-described sale.
