

SPECIAL REVENUE FUND PROJECT ORDINANCE
AMENDMENT 2024-7 (SROA 2024-13)

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Fayetteville, North Carolina, that pursuant to section 13.2 of Chapter 159 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, the following special revenue project ordinance is hereby amended:

Section 1. The project change authorized is to Special Revenue Fund Project Ordinance 2024-7, adopted August 28, 2023, for the funding of the Law Enforcement Assisted Diversion (LEAD) program through the North Carolina Harm Reduction Coalition (NCHRC).
