UDO 2-41.A-F; Historic Resources Commission

Objective: Update the enabling legislation for HRC to reflect updates to 160D

Recommendation: Update the enabling legislation for HRC to reflect updates to 160D that defines, the powers, duties, responsibilities, and appointments

UDO 30-2.A.7.A; Certificate of Appropriateness

Objective: To expand the applicability of a certificate of appropriateness (COA) to include local landmarks

Recommendation: Include language that specifically identifies the landmarks as requiring a COA outside of their inclusion in the Historic/Landmark Overlay



UDO 30-2.A.7.A; Powers and Duties

Objective: Fold landmarks back under the purview of HRC

<u>Recommendation</u>: Include specific language identifying local landmarks as under the power and authority of the HRC, outside of their inclusion in the HLO.



UDO 30-3.H.3.H.3.a; Historic Landmark Overlay

Objective: Remove landmarks from the Historic/Landmark Overlay and rename the HLO to LHO

<u>Recommendation</u>: Remove the procedure allowing the inclusion landmarks in the HLO and create a new section providing for local landmark designation exclusive of the map amendment process required for the HLO.



UDO 30-2.C.22; Local Landmark Designation Procedure (New Section)

Objective: Restore the landmark designation process exclusive of a map amendment into the HLO

Recommendation: Create a new section under Administration and Requirements for Development Approval for local landmark designation that removes the map amendment public notification requirements



UDO 30-1-9; Unified Development Ordinance

<u>Objective</u>: Rename the Historic/ Landmark Overlay (HLO) to the Local Historic Overlay District to reflect the exclusion of local landmarks from the zoning overlay

<u>Recommendation</u>: Rename the zoning overlay. Removal of the landmark procedure from the current zoning overlay (HLO) will require renaming the overlay to reflect this change.

Options and Recommendation

Options:

- Adopt draft ordinance for all proposed text amendments
- Adopt draft ordinance for specific text amendments
- Remand draft ordinances back to staff for further consideration

Recommended Action:

Adopt draft ordinance for all proposed text amendments
