

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE  
CALLING A PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING THE  
PROPOSED PERMANENT CLOSING OF A PORTION OF BULLOCK STREET

WHEREAS, the City of Fayetteville has received a request to permanently close a portion of Bullock Street. Said portion is described more particularly as follows:

BEGINNING at the southwest corner of Lot 24 as shown on the plat entitled "Map of East Bend Addition" recorded in Plat Book 7, Page 106 of the Cumberland County Registry, said corner also being in the northern right of way margin of Sapona Road and continuing thence North 78 degrees 47 minutes 01 seconds West 30.05 feet to a point, thence leaving said northern right of way of Sapona Road and continuing North 14 degrees 27 minutes 34 seconds East 321.70 feet to a point in the southern right of way margin of Haywood Street, thence along said southern right of way margin South 75 degrees 32 minutes 26 seconds East 30 feet to a point, thence leaving said southern right of way margin of Haywood Street and continuing thence South 14 degrees 27 minutes 34 seconds West 320 feet to the point of BEGINNING.

AND WHEREAS the above-described is located within the corporate limits of the City of Fayetteville and the Council intends to approve said request.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED on behalf of the people of Fayetteville, the City Council calls a public hearing on the question of the proposed closing to be held during the regular meeting of the Fayetteville City Council in Council Chambers at 433 Hay Street, 6:30 PM, June 23, 2025. Persons wishing to be heard regarding this issue shall sign up with the City Clerk, by name and home address, before 5:00 PM on the date of the scheduled public hearing as pursuant to City Council Policy 120.02.

The City Manager or his designee is directed to advertise this notice as prescribed in NCGS § 160A-299 on May 23rd, 30th, June 6th and 13th of 2025.
