- Gained federal Congressional support for the following awards:
 - \$18 million in FEMA BRIC Grants
 - \$404,867 US DOT Safe Streets 4 All Planning Grant
- Gained federal Congressional support for the following grants:
 - \$22 million US DOT RAISE Grant proposal
 - \$1.4 million for recycling education and outreach
 - \$15 million DCIP request
- Support for joint City-County Congressionally-delegated funding requests:
 - \$5 million for Fayetteville Regional Airport
 - \$2.2 million for Rural Water System Rehabilitation
