Improve roadway infrastructure and surface transportation to include streets, bridges and connections.</i>

Also advocate for Fair Housing Initiatives Program to help address veteran discrimination and barriers to fair housing.</i>

Support military infrastructure investment on and adjacent to Fort Bragg.</i> • Next Generation Workforce Development: <i>Seek opportunities to expand and enhance the City’s efforts to bolster the economy and education ecosystem in Fayetteville through the Next Generation Workforce Initiative.</i> • Corridor Improvement and Economic Development: <i>Seek funding opportunities to improve the City’s corridors supporting economic development, including the airport.</i> • I-685 Connectivity: <i>Advocate for interstate connectivity linking I-95 to the proposed I-685 using the route option</i>

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
