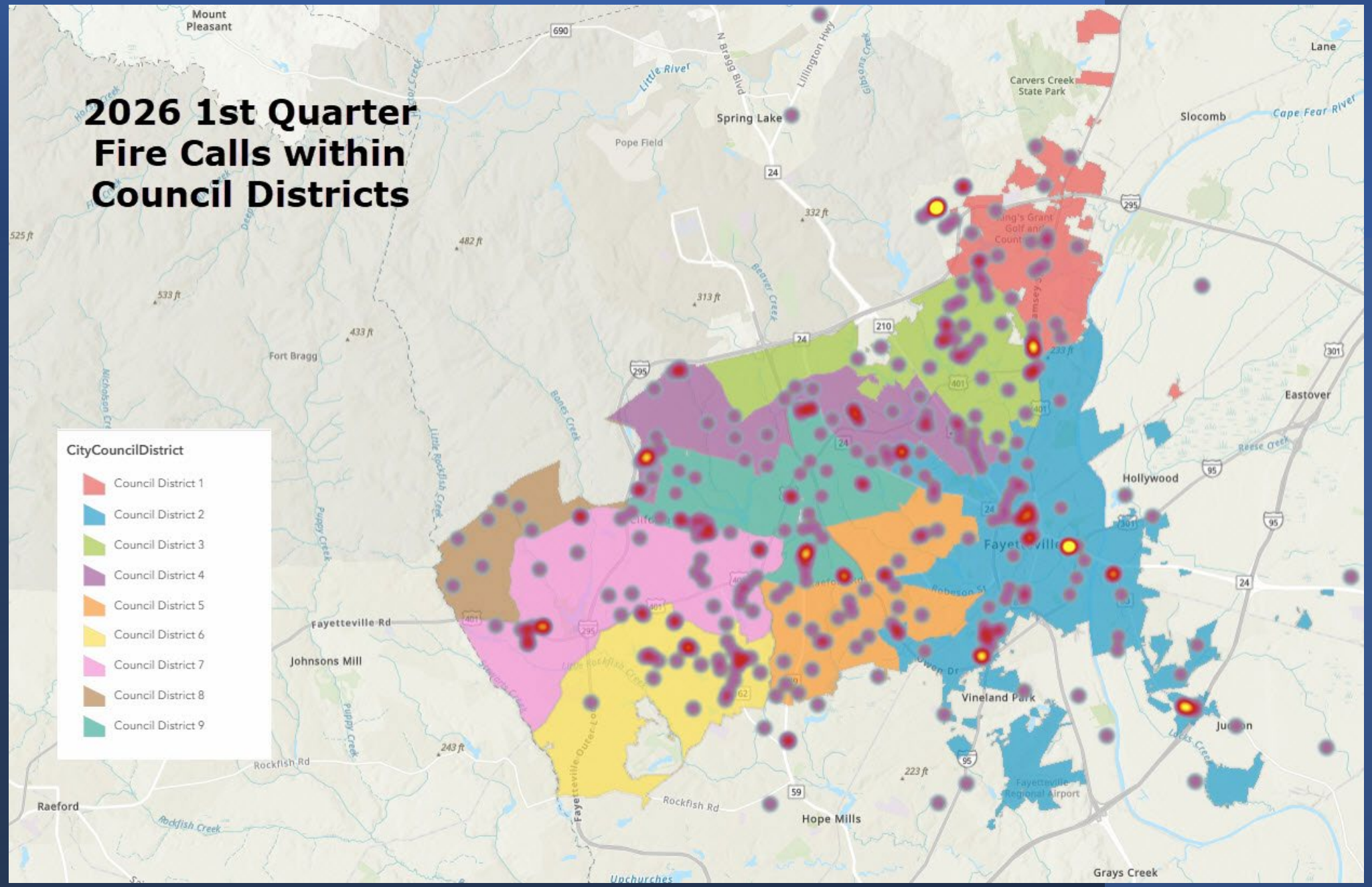

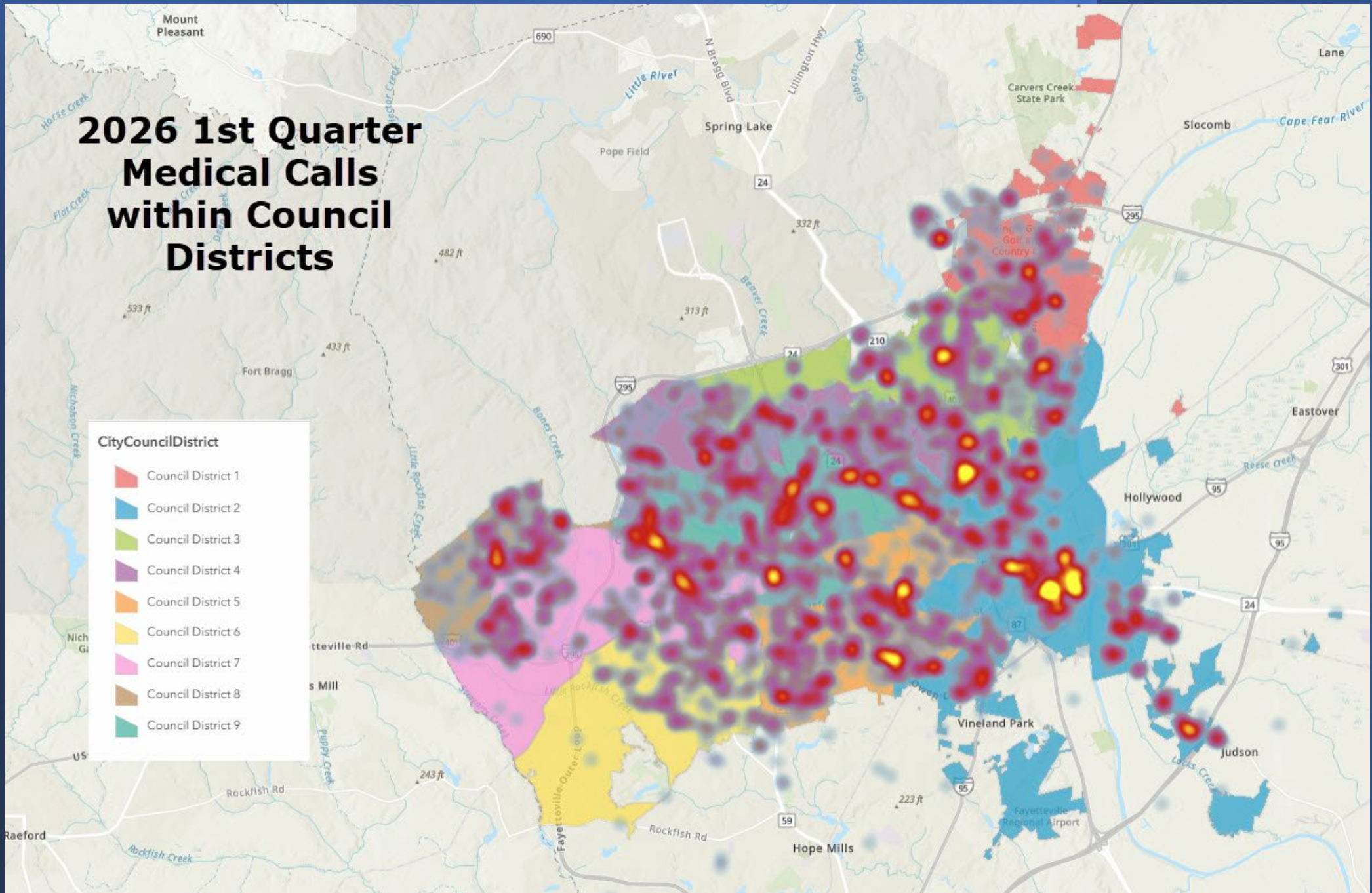
2026 1st Quarter Fire Calls within Council Districts

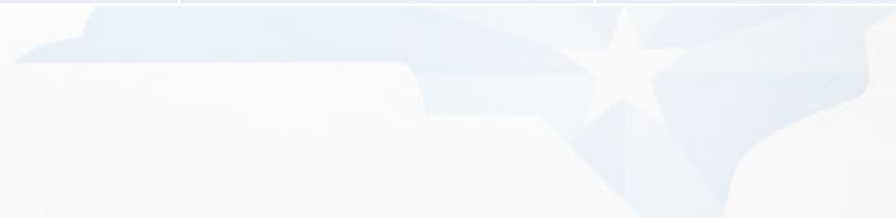

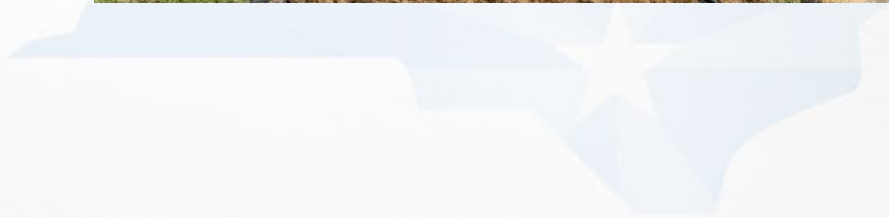

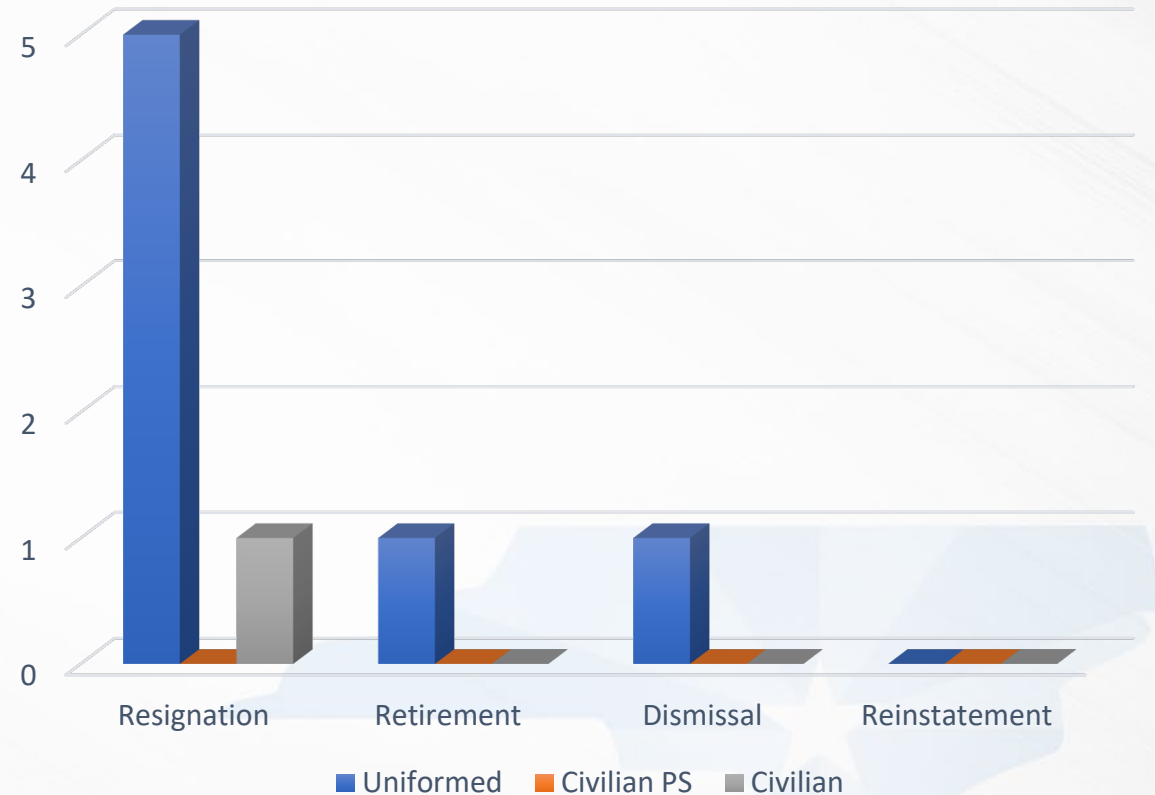

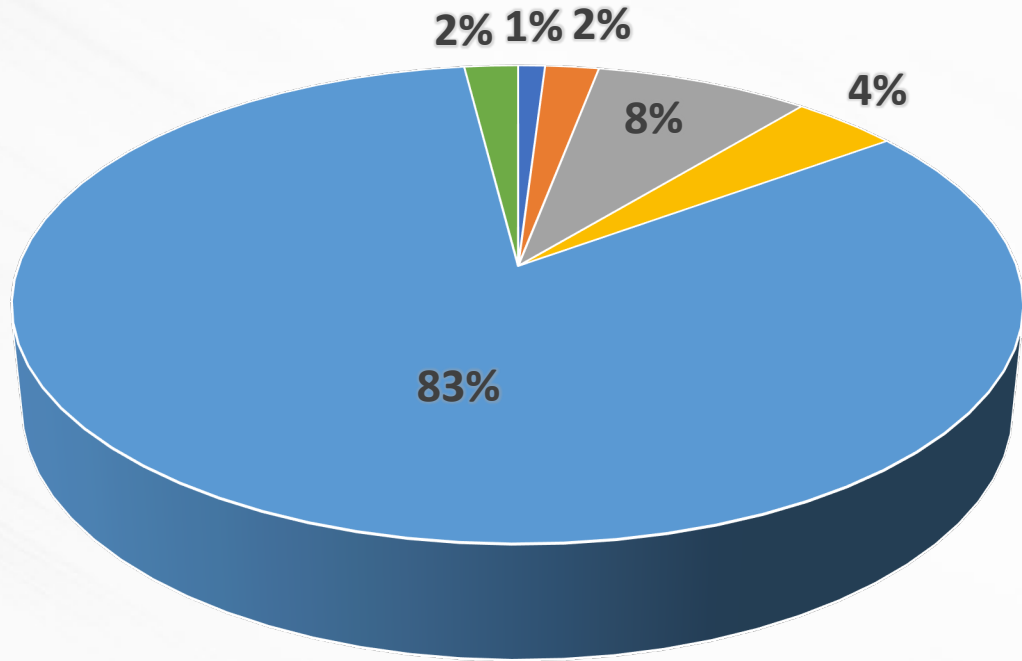

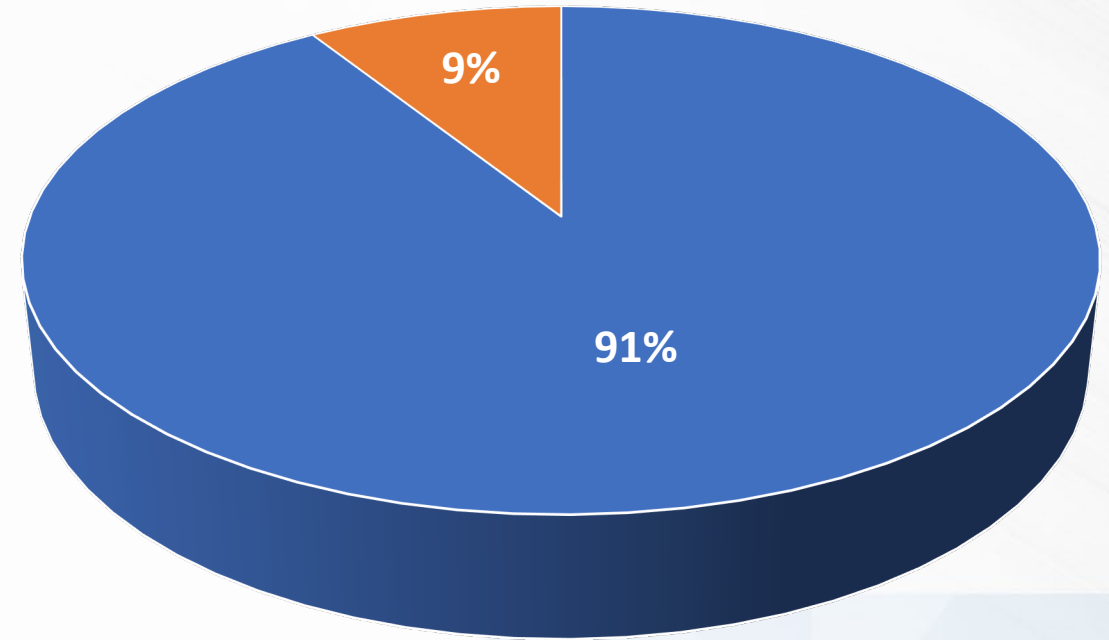
Breakdown by Race
