

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE
CONTINUING THE DOWNTOWN MUNICIPAL SERVICE DISTRICT

WHEREAS on the 26th day of June 1978, the Fayetteville City Council created a Downtown Municipal Service District pursuant to Article 23, Chapter 160A, of the North Carolina General Statutes, and that part of the report required by NCGS §160A-537(b) stated that the levy would be for a period of five (5) years, said District subsequently being reauthorized continuously through resolution, the last being approved on the 25th day of June 2018 for a five-year period through June 30, 2023;

AND WHEREAS the Fayetteville City Council, at its regular meeting on June 12, 2023, considered the reauthorization of the Downtown Municipal Service District;

AND WHEREAS following discussion on June 12, 2023, the Fayetteville City Council finds that the Downtown Municipal Service District is in need of continuing one or more of the services, facilities, or functions listed in NCGS §160A-536 to a demonstrably greater extent than the remainder of the City;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that a Downtown Municipal Service District pursuant to Chapter 160A, Article 23, of the North Carolina General Statutes is hereby continued and commonly referred to as the "Downtown Municipal Service District."

THAT this Downtown Municipal Service District shall be reauthorized.
