Ordinance No. S2022-____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE AMENDING ARTICLE 30-5, DEVELOPMENT STANDARDS, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE, NORTH CAROLINA

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Fayetteville, North Carolina, that:

Section 1. Subsection a., Festival and Major Special Event Signs, of Subsection 30-5.L.10.,

Signs Permitted by Special Approval, of Section 30-5.L., Signage, is amended by deleting the

same in its entirety and substituting with the following:

a. Festival and Major Special Event Signs

For the purpose of giving directions and information, temporary on-premises and off- premises signs pertaining to festivals and other major special events are permitted with approval by the City Manager subject to a special approval specifying size, location, lighting, design, display and duration. The number of signs shall be set by the City Manager. Such approval shall also require a compliance deposit for each sign in an amount established by the City Council. Each permitted sign must be removed upon the expiration date of the approval. The compliance deposit shall be refunded when the permitted sign(s) is removed in a timely manner upon the expiration date of the approval. In addition to the other remedies cited in this Ordinance, failure to remove a sign upon the expiration date of the approval will result in City caused sign removal and retention of the compliance deposit.

Section 2. Subsection b., Reserved, of Subsection 30-5.L.10., Signs Permitted by Special

Approval, of Section 30-5.L., Signage, is amended by deleting the same in its entirety and

substituting with the following:

b. Banners and feather flags identifying Colleges and Universities within the UC zoning district

- 1. Banners on light poles
 - a. Allowed with unified design as approved by staff.
 - b. Must be located on private poles on Colleges and Universities campus.
 - c. Maximum of 15 sq ft.
- 2. Feather flags
 - a. One feather flag is permitted per 50 feet of lot frontage.
 - b. Feather flags may be a maximum of 3 feet wide. The maximum height is 10 feet above the adjacent grade.

- c. Feather flags must be located at least 10 feet from any property line.
- d. Feather flags shall be affixed with ground mounts with the pole installed perpendicular to the ground. Above-ground mounts including but not limited to feet or legs shall not be permitted. Feather flags shall not be mounted to any other structure. No additional objects may be attached to the feather flag including but not limited to streamers, ribbons, or balloons.

Proper maintenance shall not permit banners or feather flags which are torn, ripped, frayed, broken, separated from their grommets or incompletely fixed.

Section 3. It is the intention of the City Council, and it is hereby ordained that the

provisions of this ordinance shall become and be made part of the Code or Ordinances, City of

Fayetteville, North Carolina, and the section of this ordinance may be renumbered to accomplish

such intention.
