RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE TO SUPPORT THE TOWN OF HOPE MILLS REQUEST TO REMOVE THE DESIGNATION OF NC HIGHWAY 59, TO IMPROVE SAFETY

WHEREAS, NCDOT has requested a resolution from the City of Fayetteville endorsing the Town of Hope Mills request to change the designation of NC Highway 59 between I-95 and Raeford Road by removing the primary route designation and revising it to secondary road designation; and

WHEREAS, NC 59 (Hope Mills Road) is a north/south NCDOT route that travels between US 401 (Raeford Road) and I-95, south of Hope Mills; and

WHEREAS, NC 59 (Hope Mills Road) traverses through the City of Fayetteville and the Town of Hope Mills; and

WHEREAS, the removal of the NC 59 designation will be at no cost to the City of Fayetteville and deemed to have no negative funding impacts for future NCDOT improvement projects; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE THAT:

They support the removal of the NC 59 designation within the City Limits of Fayetteville and revising it to a secondary road designation.
