## Hurricane Matthew – FEMA Funding

### **Estimated Damages by Category**

Roads	Debris Removal	Facilities, Parks, and Equipment	Emergency Protective Measures	Dams
\$3,405,271	\$3,666,440	\$2,205,127	\$185,381	\$1,544,419

#### **CDBG-DR**

- \$34,760,000 awarded to Cumberland County and the City of Fayetteville
- ☐ The City will receive \$23 million of the total amount awarded
- ☐ Public Hearings and Community Information Sessions were conducted in August and September
- ☐ City Council appropriated \$15 million at the 12/8/17 City Council meeting
- ☐ The City received the Memorandum of Agreement from the State on 1/22/18 which allows the process to begin
- Proposed projects presented to City Council in November 2017
- Projects will be prioritized over the next 5 years (2023)





## Summary Draft Project Proposal

- Includes rehabilitation/repair, reconstruction, & development
- Single-Family (for home owners and rental properties)& Multi-Family Housing (rental properties)
- ☐ Small Business Recovery Assistance
- Approx. 535 units and 100 Homeless Housed
- \$23.3 million for City CDBG-DR projects
- □ \$11.4 million for County CDBG-DR projects





## Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP)

- March 2017: All properties within the special Flood Hazard Area notified of the application process with May 15 deadline
- HMGP will address elevation, reconstruction and buyouts for qualified residents
- □3,000 residents in NC apply
- ☐ 200 Fayetteville residents apply
- ■28 properties qualified with a total funding value of \$4.7 million
- ☐ Funding will become available in April 2018



## Golden Leaf Projects

- □ Rayconda Connector- (\$920,000) Completed
- Cross Creek Tree and Debris Removal (\$300,000) Completed
- □ Spruce Street Drainage (\$873,000) Bids received on 11/18 and work projected to start in **March 2018**
- Multiple Creek Debris Removal (\$993,000) Cross Creek Bank Stabilization- Estimated completion date is **March 2018**
- □ Beaver/Bones Creek debris removal (\$786,000) Work to be completed by May 2018

Total: \$3,872,000

### **Dams**

- □55 Dams Regulated by NCDEQ
- □ II Damaged by Hurricane Matthew
- 2 Owned / Maintained by City
  - ☐ City (PWC) owns 4 other dams not damaged
- Only City Dams Eligible for FEMA/State Reimbursement
- ■No Program to Repair Private Dams



### **Dams**

- Previous Policy Did Not Support Any Dam Repairs
- Revised Policy:
  - □ Allowed Repair of City Owned/Maintained Dams
  - Private Dams Could be Considered for Repair:
    - ☐ If Public Asset, Purpose, and Access; and
    - Cost Reimbursed by Assessment



### **Dams**

- Public
  - Mirror Lake in Design
  - ■Devonwood Funding Clarified Design Firm Selection
- ■Private Engineering Evaluation
- \* Arran Lakes Dam, Rayconda Upper Dam, Rayconda Lower Dam, Strickland Bridge Dam, Lorraine Lake Dam, Cottonade Dam
