A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE FOR THE INSTALLATION OF SIDEWALK, BUS STOP PADS AND DRAINAGE UPGRADES ALONG RAEFORD ROAD

WHEREAS, NCDOT is constructing project U-4405, Raeford Road roadway improvements, from west of Hampton Oaks Drive to east of Fairway Drive and;

WHEREAS, the City of Fayetteville has requested sidewalks, bus stop pads and drainage upgrades be installed as a part of this project; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation will provide 50% of the cost for the installation of the sidewalk improvements and the City of Fayetteville will reimburse the Department of Transportation 50% of the cost of the sidewalk improvements. The City will be responsible for 100% of the cost of the bus stop pads and the drainage upgrades. The total estimated cost to the City for these improvements is \$509,760;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED on behalf of the people of Fayetteville, this Council does hereby resolve that the City of Fayetteville, North Carolina, supports and endorses the Department of Transportation's roadway project, including the installation of sidewalks, bus stop pads and drainage upgrades, along the Raeford Road roadway project. The City Manager is directed to execute the agreement necessary to pursue these improvements.
