

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE
AMENDING ARTICLE 30-9, DEFINITIONS, OF CHAPTER 30, THE UNIFIED
DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF
FAYETTEVILLE, NORTH CAROLINA**

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Fayetteville, North Carolina, that:

Section 1. Section 30-9.D., Definitions, is amended by deleting the definition of Religious Institution in its entirety and substituting the following:

Religious Institution

A structure or place in which worship, ceremonies, rituals, and education are held, together with its accessory buildings and uses (including buildings used for educational and recreational activities), operated, maintained, and controlled under the direction of a religious group. Religious institutions include churches, mosques, synagogues, and temples. Accessory uses may include school facilities, parking, temporary overflow emergency shelters for the homeless (as defined by and in compliance with the North Carolina Building Code), caretaker's housing, pastor's housing, and group living facilities such as convents.

Section 2. It is the intention of the City Council, and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this ordinance shall become and be made part of the Code or Ordinances, City of Fayetteville, North Carolina, and the section of this ordinance may be renumbered to accomplish such intention.
