## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CONVEYANCE OF TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY TO FAYETTEVILLE TECHNICAL COMMUNITY COLLEGE

**WHEREAS,** Fayetteville Technical Community College is proposing to initiate and operate a program to train electric lineworkers, which is expected to be beneficial to the Fayetteville Public Works Commission by increasing the pool of eligible applicants to fill highly skilled positions and to be beneficial to the City of Fayetteville by increasing the number of high wage employees living in the City of Fayetteville.

WHEREAS, in order to initiate and operate the program to train electric lineworkers, Fayetteville Technical Community College has requested from the Fayetteville Public Works Commission equipment owned by the Fayetteville Public Works Commission as well as supplies and other tangible personal property over which the Fayetteville Public Works Commission exercises management and control in its utility operations but which is titled in the name of the City of Fayetteville in accordance with Chapter VIA of the Charter of the City of Fayetteville; and

**WHEREAS,** the City of Fayetteville agrees that the terms and conditions negotiated by the Fayetteville Public Works Commission and Fayetteville Technical Community College for the conveyance of such personal property and the operation of the training program are reasonable and the transaction is authorized under G.S. 160A-274 and should be permitted;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Fayetteville that the Fayetteville Public Works Commission is hereby authorized to transfer and convey supplies and tangible personal property to Fayetteville Technical Community College for its electric lineworker program.
