## CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO AMEND THE CITY CHARTER TO CHANGE THE MODE OF ELECTING THE CITY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, N.C.G.S. § 160A-102 authorizes the City Council to amend the City of Fayetteville Charter to implement any of the optional forms of government set forth in N.C.G.S. § 160A-101; and

WHEREAS, one of the options listed in N.C.G.S. § 160A-101 provides that members of the City Council may serve terms of office of either two or four years; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to consider amending the City of Fayetteville Charter to provide the members of the Mayor and City Council the said terms of office of four years; and

WHEREAS, the proposed change would occur during the next municipal election in November 2019, for the Mayor and Council members to be elected to four-year terms; and

WHEREAS, N.C.G.S. § 160A-102 requires the City Council to hold a public hearing on the proposed Charter amendment prior to its adoption.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Fayetteville that it intends to consider adopting an ordinance amending the relevant provisions of the City of Fayetteville Charter as to the length and expiration date of the terms of the members of the City Council; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a public hearing to consider the proposed Charter amendment shall be held on May 28, 2018, and that notice thereof shall be duly advertised in accordance with N.C.G.S. § 160A-102.
