A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING THE PROPOSED CLOSING OF A PORTION OF SHENANDOAH DRIVE

WHEREAS, the City of Fayetteville has received a request to permanently close a portion of Shenandoah Drive. Said portion is described more particularly as follows:

BEGINNING at an existing iron stake in the southeast corner of that parcel described in Deed Book 4402, Page 188 known as Lot 2 of the Resubdivision of Lot 2 Hildegard P. Smith Property recorded in Plat Book 58, Page 58 of the Cumberland County Registry and continuing thence North 79 degrees 32 minutes 07 seconds East 183.76 feet to a point thence South 09 degrees 50 minutes 00 seconds East 60 feet to a point, thence South 79 degrees 32 minutes 07 seconds West 183.76 feet to a point, thence North 09 degrees 50 minutes 00 seconds West 60 feet to the BEGINNING, and containing approximately 11,004.89 square feet.

AND WHEREAS the above-described is located within the corporate limits of the City of Fayetteville and the Council intends to approve said request.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED on behalf of the people of Fayetteville, the City Council calls a public hearing on the question of the proposed closing to be held during the regular meeting of the Fayetteville City Council in Council Chambers at 433 Hay Street, 7:00 PM, June 25, 2018. Persons wishing to be heard regarding this issue must register in advance with the City Clerk in the Executive Offices, Second Floor, City Hall, 433 Hay Street, prior to the hearing date or at Council Chambers between 6:30 – 7:00 PM on the evening of the hearing.

The City Manager or his designee is directed to advertise this notice as prescribed in NCGS 160A-299 on May 22^{nd} , 29^{th} , June 5^{th} , and 12^{th} 2018.
