

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE
CALLING FOR A REFERENDUM FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO A
VOTE AN ORDINANCE IMPLEMENTING FOUR-YEAR TERMS FOR THE
MEMBERS OF THE FAYETTEVILLE CITY COUNCIL**

WHEREAS, pursuant to G.S. 160A-101 and 160A-102, the City Council of the City of Fayetteville enacted an ordinance on June 25, 2018, amending the Charter of the City of Fayetteville as set forth in Chapter 557 of the 1979 Session Laws of North Carolina, as amended, to implement four-year terms for the members of the Fayetteville City Council; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to G.S. 160A-102, the ordinance provides that it will become effective only if approved by a vote of the people.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE City Council of the City of Fayetteville that:

1. A general election will be held on November 6, 2018, and will include a vote of the people for the purpose of determining whether the members of the Fayetteville City Council shall be elected for four-year terms.

2. Pursuant to G.S. 163A-1592 the Cumberland County Board of Elections is hereby requested to conduct the election herein described and the City Clerk is directed to forthwith deliver a copy of this resolution to said Board of Elections.

3. Pursuant to G.S. 160A-102, the City Clerk shall cause to be duly published in accordance with G.S. 163A-1592 a notice of the election hereby called.

4. The election shall be held in accordance with Article 23, Chapter 163A of the General Statutes of North Carolina.
