

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE
REGARDING DOWNTOWN PARKING

WHEREAS, the Council adopted a Resolution No. R2017-[inset number] Regarding Downtown Parking Availability During The Construction Of The Baseball Stadium And Associated Development Projects on September 25, 2017 delegating authority to take action to regulate parking during construction of the baseball stadium and associated development projects; and

WHEREAS, the construction of Segra Stadium is substantially complete and has started operation, but associated development and construction activity continues; and

WHEREAS, the operation of Segra Stadium and other events in the downtown occasionally create parking operation conflicts that need to be addressed on a case by case basis; and

WHEREAS, downtown business and their employees have been impacted by event parking and the continued financial success of downtown business is an important community interest; and

WHEREAS, a comprehensive parking management program and significant parking resources are currently in the development stage.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Fayetteville that:

1. The City Manager shall have the authority to designate differential rates, designate specific parking locations for specific purposes, provide parking passes, or take other actions deemed necessary and appropriate to manage the parking needs of events and businesses in the downtown.

2. It shall be unlawful for anyone except the aforementioned to park in spaces so designated without a proper permit. The penalty for a violation of this section shall be the same as a City Hall Lot violation penalty listed in the fees schedule adopted by City Council.

3. The City Manager shall have the authority to set the specific parking regulation enforcement hours between 7 am and 12 am.

4. Any sworn law enforcement officer may direct that a motor vehicle be towed if in the opinion of such law enforcement officer the motor vehicle is blocking or impeding the flow of vehicular traffic within a parking lot designated for the aforementioned or is blocking or impeding access to or from a properly designated and/or marked parking space within the parking lot.

6. The authority granted hereby is in addition to that provided by previous action of the Council or otherwise in existence.

7. This resolution shall become effective upon adoption by the City Council and remain in effect until rescinded or replaced by Council action.
